A year and 4 months ago the vestry of St. Andrew resolved to love the way Christ loves, by inviting Laura, Jose, and Joshua into sanctuary at St. Andrew. We acted swiftly, by necessity, after much prayer, to insure that Laura, a single mother born in Mexico and living/working in the US for over 15 years, was not separated from her young sons through summary deportation.

It was a bold decision for our church leadership to make, and it was not without its detractors within the body. Some left us over this decision, and some stayed but distanced themselves from the family, the body of Christ, and sanctuary support activities. The vast majority of our membership, however, prayed for this family without ceasing and helped, in myriad ways, to make their time with us a true gift of love courtesy of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. For this I am eternally grateful. By your love, made manifest in sanctuary, you have strengthened my faith, and the faith of many inside and outside the church.
